1.1 NSW Health Facility Guidelines

- The Australasian HFGs replaced the existing NSW HFGs effective **30 March 2007**

1.2 Australasian Health Facility Guidelines

- Governance – all States of Australia and NZ Ministry of Health
- The [Australasian Health Facility Guidelines - Revision v2.0](#) has been endorsed by HCAMC for industry use by all jurisdictions in Australia and New Zealand, commencing 23 November 2007.
- Status dependent on jurisdictional requirements

Generic sections reviewed for Australasian use

- Part A (administrative provisions)
- Part B (general, standard components)
- Part C (access, mobility, OHS)
- Part D (infection control)

Generic Sections developed for Australasian use

- Part E Engineering Services

Generic Section to remain NSW specific

- Part F Project Implementation



AUSTRALASIAN HFG CURRENT STATUS

Workplan 2008 to include

- Address 'usability' issues for the HFG – including search function, hyperlinked index, and other functions to be determined following feedback from users
- Continue work on development and review of HPU sections including preliminary work on making them appropriate for Australasia and finalising in response to industry review and commentary
- Review Part C Access Mobility and OHS
- Review Part D Infection Control
- Review older NSW HPU sections and associated Standard Components in more detail e.g. Inpatient Unit, Operating Unit, Child & Adolescent Mental Health Unit, Medical Imaging etc
- New HPU for Acute Age Care Unit/Rehabilitation, Mental Health Unit for Older People, Non Acute Mental Health Unit, Cardiac Services Unit (CCU, step-down, catheter labs and diagnostics) etc.
