Asset Services is involved in the project through SA Department of Health membership of the Health Capital and Asset Management Consortium of Australasia (HCAMC) which is a committee comprising the Asset Directors of the Health Departments of all Australian states and New Zealand and is endorsed by the Australian Health Ministers Advisory Council.

HCAMC has commissioned CHAA to undertake the development of Australasian Health Facility Guidelines, consolidating work undertaken in several of the States.

Asset Services is coordinating use and review of the guidelines on SA Health capital projects. The seminar will include a discussion of how the guidelines relate to recent projects and the intentions for their ongoing implementation.
